

## **2018 RECITAL TICKET INFORMATION**

**Tickets go on sale: Saturday, April 21<sup>st</sup>**

**Time: 8:30-10:30 AM**

**Place: Summit On The Park**

**Price: \$17.00**

**\*\*Each family will be eligible to purchase 15 tickets on the 21<sup>st</sup>. IF YOU CANNOT PURCHASE YOUR TICKETS ON SATURDAY, APRIL 21<sup>st</sup> FROM 8:30-10:30 AM, THEY WILL BE AVAILABLE ON MONDAY, APRIL 23<sup>rd</sup> at the Summit Front Desk. On Tuesday, April 24<sup>th</sup>, remaining tickets are upstairs with the dance staff. In order to be fair to all families, no one will be allowed to pick up more than 15 tickets on Saturday, April 21<sup>st</sup> or Monday, April 23<sup>rd</sup>. However, an alternate may pick up and sign for your tickets as long as they are picking up no more tickets or the combination of their tickets and yours does not exceed 15. BE SURE YOU KNOW AHEAD OF TIME WHAT NIGHT YOUR DAUGHTER DANCES AND HOW MANY TICKETS YOU NEED.**

**THERE WILL BE TICKET SALES AT THE DOOR DURING RECITALS. You will not be allowed to select your seat assignment; however, the earlier you buy your tickets, the closer to the stage you will be.**

1. To speed up ticket sales we have incorporated a few changes the last few years and put all procedures in print so there is as little confusion as possible. Also, dance mothers will be helping with ticket sales so please be nice to these volunteers.
2. Every family is required to purchase a minimum of 4 tickets to help cover expensive recital costs including renting the auditorium, stage assistance, programs, etc. Maximum of 15 tickets per family on the first two days of sales. The only exception is families who have two students, who do not dance any of their numbers in the same show. These families are allowed 15 tickets per student.
3. Recital Aides- The mothers working recital (recital aides) have a complimentary seat with their dance group they are chaperoning. These seats will be reserved. Recital aide families may still purchase 15 tickets on Saturday or Monday and do not need to count the complimentary seat saved for the recital aide.
4. Tickets will be sold in seat order. As ticket sellers reach the end of a row, they will "wrap around" to the next row.
5. Everyone requires a ticket. A suggestion for very young siblings is to bring them to a dress rehearsal instead since the recital may be too long for them.
6. Parents can speed up the procedure when purchasing tickets by:
  - A. Completing the ticket form in line.
  - B. Having a check made out to DANCIN' FEET for the number of tickets purchasing (\$17.00 each). Cash is also accepted.
  - C. Have your license number on the check.
  - D. Limit your ticket purchase to one or two recitals the first day of sales.
  - E. If your child is in multiple recitals and under the age of **11**, at least one parent must purchase a ticket to that recital.
  - F. Understand you can get tickets on Monday, Tuesday or later if you do not want to stand in line.
